HOKKAIDO SKI TOUR

Hokkaido is one of the few places in Japan where you can enjoy high quality dry powder snow that is world class. There are many large scale ski resorts complete with hotels, condominiums, and other types of lodging facilities right on the slopes. Of such resorts, the Niseko area is especially popular amongst domestic and foreign skiers and snowboarders. There are also a number of ski slopes right around central Sapporo, making access from downtown to the piste easy. This great ski environment is unlike any other parts of Japan.

KIRORO

Helicopter trips to Shiribetsu-Dake volcano (1,107 meters high), famous for fresh powder snow lines and steep ridges covered by beautiful birch forest.

The average vertical height is 650 meters (2,130 feet) per run, which means you'll be bagging over 3,000 meters vertically with 1 full-day helicopter package.
