
there is only minimal traffic but so many breathtaking beautiful scenic sites such as the Shiretoko National Park, a natural world heritage site, Lake Mashu, Lake Kussharo and more that attract inbound tourists from around the world. During flower season, Koshimizu Gensei Kaen, a primary wildflower sanctuary, gorgeous dainty wildflowers bloom at once. If you feel physically confident, we recommend you cycle through the Shiretoko Pass, around Lake Saroma and Lake Akan.

Natural World Heritage SHIRETOKO

shiretoko was recognized as a natural world heritage in July, 2005, and is considered the "Final Wilderness" of Hokkaido. The geography of the area that repels people, the environment and drift ice create a rich marine ecosystem, while the primary wilderness creates a rich ecosystem for its inhabitants on land. Here there is everything from fields, forests, and mountains to rivers, wetlands and lakes all crowded into one area where many endangered species such as Ezo deer, brown bears, whales, orcas, White-tailed Eagles and Steller's Sea Eagles live.





MODEL COURSE

Day 1 Memanbetsu Airport -Hot Spring Inn on Lake Akan

Day 2 Cycle along the coast of the Okhotsk Sea and to Natural World Heritage, Shiretoko

Day 3 Drive to Shari, cycle from Shari to
Lake Mashu
Return to Lake Akan by car and cycle
around the lake.

Day 4 Cycle from Lake Akan
through the Kushiro Wetlands and
to Kushiro.
Travel from Kushiro
to Tokachigawa Hot Springs by car.

Day 5 Tokachigawa Hot Springs to

New Chitose Airport, return home.
